

It encourages learning from various approaches, reflecting on experiences, and developing personalized teaching styles based on individual beliefs. The text underscores ongoing learning and adaptation for effective teaching rather than solely relying on established methods.
- B.
English teachers need to explore innovative teaching beyond established methods. Also, it is important to understand various language education approaches, drawing from valuable experiences for a solid foundation. They will be able to master by learning when and how to use diverse methods, understanding education history, and engaging in reflective language learning.
- C.
Subconscious application of principles, drawn from methods or developed through experience, influences classroom activities. Clark and Peterson (1986) emphasize growth beyond using methods. Gaining practical knowledge from various methods forms the foundation of instruction, contributing to exploring and improving personal beliefs, principles, and practices.
- D.
Teachers benefit from diverse language education approaches beyond the mainstream. Learning their usage, history, and reflective experiences enhances teaching. It fosters exploration and improvement of personal beliefs and practices.
